LEVERAGE EXAMPLES

Wilgraaghebben.nl modernization (Feb 25 to Mar 1, 2026): 50 commits in 5 calendar days. One commit swapped Bootstrap 2.0.4 to 5.3.3 and jQuery 1.7.2 to 3.7.1 across 58 files. Adjacent work landed in parallel via fan-out agent workstreams: GDPR consent, GA4, drag-and-drop reordering, ARIA pass, Open Graph extractor, DB migrations. Playwright suite grown 36 to 103 tests, all green. A quarter-long initiative for two engineers, compressed into a long weekend.

Runnerts.nl greenfield build (Oct 2025 to Apr 2026): 213 commits across 41 active days. Laravel 12 + Vue 3 + Inertia, built with Laravel Boost MCP and a three-agent loop (development, testing, orchestration). Single-day commits closed whole phases: 118-file i18n pass, 39-file public event system with QR ticketing, 57-file role-hierarchy refactor inside a 26-commit day. 489-test suite green at the end. A year-long contract for three engineers, shipped in 41 active days.
